



The 18th International Conference on WWW/Internet was hosted in Cagliari, Italy (during 7 to 9 November, 2019).

This conference was organized by the International Association for Development of the Information Society and co-organized by University of Cagliari, Faculty of Engineering and Architecture, Cagliari, Italy.

The WWW/Internet conference tried to address the main issues of concern within WWW/Internet. WWW and Internet had a huge development in recent years. Aspects of concern are no longer just technical anymore but other aspects have arisen. This conference aims to cover both technological as well as non-technological issues related to these developments. Its broad areas of interest were Web 2.0, Semantic Web and XML, Applications and Uses, Services, Architectures and Web Development and Research Issues.



The 2019 edition received 103 submissions from more than 19 countries. Each submission was anonymously reviewed by an average of four independent reviewers, to ensure the final high standard of the accepted submissions. The final result was the approval of 16 full papers, which meant that the acceptance rate was 16%. A few more papers have been accepted as short and doctoral papers and posters/demonstrations.

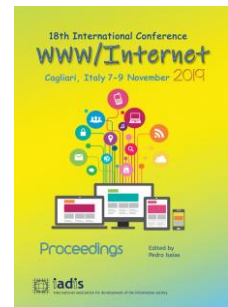
